

THE ALIGNMENT HIT LIST

Chip was working on a routine alignment when things went sideways. While adjusting the toe bolt, he decided to pull the wrench toward himself instead of pushing away. The bolt was seized, so when it finally broke loose, the wrench shot back with full force.



Prevent Future Alignment Injuries:

- Push, Don't Pull: Avoid elbow strikes during toe adjustments.
- Control Your Tools: Grip firmly and wear the REQUIRED face shield & gloves.
- Check Before Force: Inspect bolts and use penetrating oil.
- Stay Aware: Practice 360° awareness around racks or under vehicles.

THAT'S JACKED UP (IN THE WRONG PLACE)

Jack damage trending up, 160 claims in October!

In both pictures the technician thought they placed the jack pad on the pinch weld or proper lift point without verifying. No matter how many times you lift a vehicle, **ALWAYS** check where the jack pad is located to make sure it's in position.

Double-check before you lift


- Locate lift point
- Visually confirm pad positionJack up slowly
- if you hear cracking!


