# Schrader Compressor

#### What and Why

- All Schrader compressors within each region must be identified and accounted for by store number and then inspected due to a potential hazard.
- The stores' Safety Leaders will collect the manufacturer names and serial numbers.
- You will receive the list of Schrader compressor serial numbers and their respective store numbers (specific to your region) from the Technical Team at Corporate.

#### **Action**

#### Warehouse Adjustment Manager or Maintenance Manager:

- Confirm the number of "Schrader" manufactured compressors in the region along with their serial numbers.
  - If the serial number is incorrect enter the correct serial number in iAuditor during the "Final Step."
- Perform a visual inspection of each Schrader compressor.
  - You will receive written inspection procedures through iAuditor
  - If a compressor is found to be defective, follow the Lock out/Tag out procedures (attached: Document 58466, Published 3/29/16, ver. 1.0).
- If the Lock out/Tag out devices are not available:
  - Use any lock on the electrical box
  - Cut the power cord on the auto-drain
  - Use heavy duty tape to ensure the ball valve remains closed from the system
