Loading Dock Safety Tips

General Hazards

 Loading docks are high-traffic zones with potential dangers such as falling objects, machinery, protruding materials, and heat or cold stress.

Slips, Trips, and Falls

 Ensure walkways are clear of obstructions like pallets or materials, and keep floors dry. Clean up spills immediately and report any damaged flooring.

Pallet and Racking Safety

 Inspect pallets for damage before use, ensure proper load capacity, and use the right size for racks. Racking should be installed properly and regularly inspected for damage. Damaged racks should be tagged and repaired promptly.

Personal Protective Equipment (PPE)

• Workers should wear gloves, steel-toed boots, safety glasses, and hard hats as appropriate for their tasks.

Manual Handling

• Follow proper lifting techniques, and use ergonomically placed storage to reduce strain. Always ask for help if necessary to lift heavy items.


Additional Safety Practices

 Be aware of sharp objects and protrusions when unpacking crates, and ensure tools like knives are used safely. Clean up loading areas regularly and report any safety concerns.

INGREDIENTS:

- 1/2lb ground sausage
- 1/2lb lean ground beef
- 1 pckg ready-to-serve Spanish rice
- 4 large poblano peppers
- 1 c enchilada sauce
- ½ c shredded Mexican cheese
- minced fresh cilantro

DIRECTIONS:

1. Preheat broiler. In a large skillet, cook sausage and beef over medium heat until no longer pink, 5-7 minutes, breaking meat into crumbles; drain.

- 2. Prepare rice according to package directions, then, add the rice to the meat mixture.
- 3. Cut peppers lengthwise in half and remove the seeds. Place on a foil lined baking pan, cut side down. Broil 4" from heat until skins blister, about 5 minutes. With tongs, carefully turn peppers.
- 4. Fill with mixture; top with enchilada sauce and sprinkle with cheese. Broil until cheese melts. Top with cilantro if desired, and enjoy!




