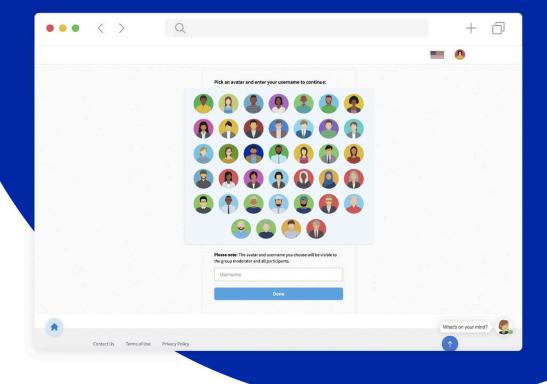


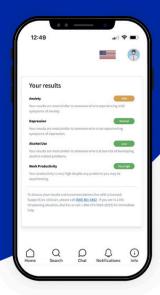




Digital group support

Purpose

Heat & Hydration

- Drink water every 15 20 minutes
- · Wear light, breathable clothing
- Rest in shade/cool areas
- Know heat exhaustion vs. heat stroke (call 911 for stroke)
- Use cooling gear like vests or wraps

😂 Sun & Skin Safety

- Use SPF 30+ sunscreen
- · Wear hats and UV-blocking sunglasses
- Avoid direct sun from 10 AM 4 PM
- · Check your skin for unusual changes

Smart Hydration

- · Track intake don't wait to feel thirsty
- Avoid sugary/caffeinated drinks
- · Replenish electrolytes in extreme heat

▲ Common Hazards

- · Fatigue can impair judgment take breaks
- Use insect repellent; treat bites promptly
- Identify and avoid poison ivy, oak, and sumac
- · Watch for wet floors and wear slip-resistant shoes

Other Summer Safety

- Never leave kids or pets in cars
- · Check tire pressure heat raises blowout risk
- Use grill safely keep away from structures
- Know CPR and never swim alone

CREAMY LEMON HERB CHICKEN

INGREDIENTS

1/2 cup

all-purpose flour

Kosher salt and black pepper, to taste

2 Tbsp. olive oil

6 (4-oz.) boneless, skinless chicken thighs

1/4 cup white wine

3 garlic cloves, grated on a microplane

3/4 cup heavy cream

1/2 cup finely grated parmesan

1 lemon, zested and juiced

2 Tbsp. roughly chopped parsley

2 Tbsp. roughly chopped dill

2 Tbsp. sliced chives

2 Tbsp. thinly sliced basil

Lemon wedges, for serving

DIRECTIONS

- Add the flour to a shallow bowl and season with salt and pepper. Heat a large skillet over medium-high, then add the oil.
- 2. Meanwhile, dredge the chicken in the flour, shaking off any excess. When the oil is shimmering, add the chicken to the pan and fry until golden brown and cooked through, 4 to 6 minutes per side. Transfer to a plate and set aside.
- 3. Carefully add the wine to the pan. Using a wooden spoon, scrape up any brown bits on the bottom of the pan to release the flavor, then add the garlic, cream, parmesan, lemon zest and juice, and a little more salt and pepper. Bring to a simmer and continue cooking until the sauce thickens slightly, 2 to 3 minutes.
- 4. Taste and adjust the seasonings with a little more salt and pepper as necessary, then stir in about three-fourths of the parsley, dill, chives, and basil. Return the chicken to the pan, turning to coat. Sprinkle with the remaining herbs and serve immediately with more lemon wedges.

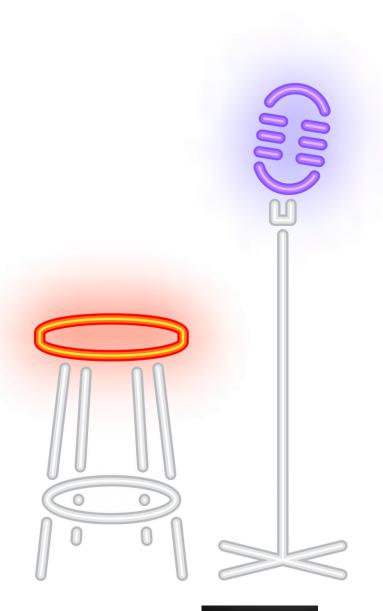
