

SP 3000 Series Rider Pallet Trucks

1. Notify your supervisor or maintenance department if this light comes on. A
2. Check this during your pre-shift inspection. B
3. Applying the brakes turns off power to the drive motor. B
4. All Stockpickers intended to use pallets are equipped with pallet clamps. B
5. ALWAYS use your belt & tether regardless of how high you will lift. B
6. The emergency disconnect cuts all power to the truck and should be used in an emergency. It does not physically separate the battery connector. B
7. They can be raised to help in picking, or to exit a loaded truck. Power for traction is cut when a side gate is raised. A
8. Any of these could cause the problem. D
9. Remember, plugging will not stop the truck as quickly as braking. A
10. Check this when starting out. B
11. Be sure there is no binding in this control during your pre-shift inspection. A
12. This is for your protection. NEVER operate a truck that has safety devices bypassed. A
13. All elements are important to protect others and the truck. D
14. Push the same button further to a second position for the faster speed. A
15. You must be on the pedal to travel A
